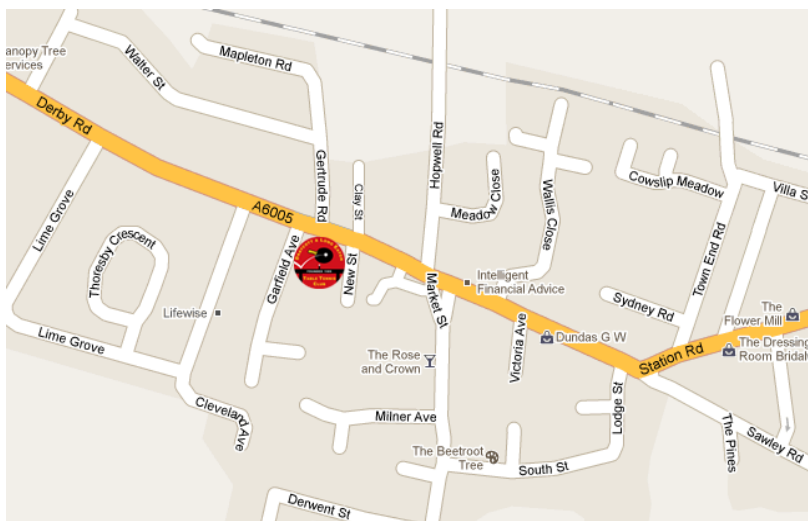


### Venue Location and Directions:

Draycott is only 10 minutes from the M1 and is situated between Derby & Nottingham.

From Junction 25 of the M1 take the A52 towards Derby. After 3 miles turn left (signposted Draycott) into Cole Lane. At the bottom of Cole Lane turn Right (towards Borrowash). Take the 4th left (signposted A6005) to Draycott, Breaston & Long Eaton. On entering Draycott keep a look out for the Draycott Table Tennis Centre on the right hand side, to the right of the Chip Shop. There is ample car parking to the rear of the premises.

The centre consists of an 18.3m x 11m Community Hall and a larger purpose-built 22m x 12m Table Tennis Hall. On site there are toilets, changing facilities, showers, a social area and disabled facilities.

### **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**

- The Derbyshire County Closed Table Tennis Championships are held under Table Tennis England Regulations and entries will be to those, who are player members of an Association/League affiliated to the Association, player members of a directly affiliated club, directly affiliated individuals and members of organisations of good standing, with the exception that only players, who are eligible for selection for the County in County Championship matches can enter the Championships. In the event of a dispute the decision of the Organising Committee will be final.
- All singles competitions will be drawn into groups where possible. Further rounds will be played on the knock out principle as will doubles events and the first round will be drawn. All matches will be on the 11 up scoring system and the best of five games. The top 2 Players in the initial Groups will qualify for the main knockout stage.
- The Organising Committee will carry out the seeding.
- Umpires will be provided from within the group. Following group play the losing player/s of each match must remain at the table to be available to umpire the next match.
- Players must report to the Referees table on arrival and permission must be obtained to leave the sports hall.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to restrict entries and cancel events. No entry will be accepted after the draw has taken place.
- Players must wear rubber-soled shoes in the sports hall.
- Match Balls will be white Joola.
- The umpire's decision on points of fact will be final. The Referees decision on points of law disputes and interpretation of Regulations shall be final.
